SIPRO – Italian Society of Prosthetics and Oral Rehabilitation announces the call for the best research work and clinical cases. These will be presented in the form of poster (in a dedicated area) during the 5th International Congress “*Tooth- and Implant-Supported Prosthodontics in the Digital Era: From Preparation to Finalization*” to be held in Naples (Stazione Marittima Congress Center) from September 25 to 26, 2026.

Categories:

- 1) Research in Prosthetics.
- 2) Research in Digital Prosthetics.
- 3) Clinical Research.
- 4) Clinical Cases.

The Abstracts must be sent using the appropriate form that can be filled in on the website:

<https://siprotesi.it/competitionon/> **by 31 July 2026** and comply with the following:

- Each Presenter can present only one abstract, but there is no limit on number of co-Authors;
- Each Abstract is permitted a maximum of 10 co-Authors;
- Each Abstract is permitted a maximum of 10 affiliations.

If accepted, the Presenter will be notified via e-mail approximately 1 month before the Congress. The paper poster in vertical format displayed at the Congress must have the following format A0 84cm base x 120cm h)

When submitting an abstract, all authors must adhere to the following:

1. Affirm that any work with human subjects or animals complies with the Guiding Principles for Experimental Procedures contained in the Declaration of Helsinki of the World Medical Association
2. Declare that the work has never been presented or published (in paper or electronic format).
3. Agree that, if the abstract is accepted, SIPRO has permission to publish the abstract in electronic format.
4. Agree to pre-register for the Congress and pay the registration fee. Failure to pre-register will result in the withdrawal of the abstract and the speaker will not be invited to present his/her work at the SIPRO 2025 International Congress, and it will not be published on DOCTORS OS, ed. Tecniche Nuove.

The best Research selected by the Evaluating Committee (1 for each category) will be awarded **the SIPRO 2026 Prize (free registration both at the Society and the Congress 2027)**.

The best Clinical Case selected by the Evaluating Committee **will be awarded the SIPRO 2026 Prize (free registration both at the Society and the Congress 2027)**.

Among the four winning works, two will be selected for the award of an international study trip.

The Evaluating Committee may give special mentions of merit which will not be associated with any awards.

Guidelines for Abstract submission

Abstracts must be written exclusively in English.

Research

The abstract must be either basic, laboratory or clinical research (clinical trials, innovative operational or surgical techniques), More important is the relevance to biology and prosthetics.

Please use the [appropriate electronic form](#) on the website and enter:

- A concise title limited to 15 words or less;
- A list of authors, with the presenter listed as the first author, name and surname for each author (and affiliation). The abstract should be divided in to the follow sections:

Aim - Max. 500 characters, including spaces;

Materials and Methods - Max. 1000 characters, including spaces;

Results - Max. 1000 characters, including spaces;

Conclusions - Max. 500 characters, including spaces.

Figures and tables (up to a maximum of 7) can be inserted and must be described.

Evaluation criteria are: Originality of the hypothesis, study design, methodology, scientific and clinical relevance.

- Clinical Case

The case presented must concern a clinical case that addresses the analysis of prosthetics with particular attention to instrumentation, innovation and anatomy. It is also acceptable for the presentation of case reports or case series of prosthetic interest in both the clinical and surgical area.

Please use the appropriate [electronic form on the website](#) and enter:

Background - Max. 500 characters, including spaces;

Case report - Max. 1500 characters, including spaces;

Conclusions - Max. 500 characters, including spaces.

Evaluation criteria for case reports and series are: Case documentation, rational for treatment, clinical results.

Please use WeTransfer and submit to the following e-mail address: sipro.protesi@gmail.com the following materials:

- a minimum of 6 to a maximum of 12 high resolution TIF or JPEG images (minimum resolution 300 dpi, 6x9cm print format);
- a brief caption of the images.

The Clinical and Radiographic documentation should include the main treatment dates.

The Evaluating Committee reserves the right to request any revisions or additions which must sent back by the Author no later than 5 days from receipt of the communication and the re-proposed work must have the same structure and the same number of characters imposed by the regulation of the first Abstract presented.
